# Incoterms® 2020

Incoterms®, or **IN**ternational **CO**mmercial **TERMS**, were created in 1936 by the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) in order to harmonize and unify the world trade.

The last update took place in 2010: trade has changed so much in 10 years that the update was necessary to follow the current business practices. Incoterms® added to the sales contract act as « international language » in order to reduce the possible interpretations as to the responsibility of each

party involved. Incoterms® define the responsibilities of buyers and sellers concerning the delivery of goods uder sales contracts. Incoterms® 2020 take into account the lastest developments in commercial practice, updates and include some of the old rules.

The new classification system divides the 11 Incoterms® into two distinct groups :

# Multimodal Incoterms (regardless of the mode of transport)

#### **EXW** Ex works

# CIP Carriage and insurance paid to
